AI Policy:

Generative artificial intelligence, commonly referred to as AI, has the following restrictive allowance when used by authors submitting their manuscripts to the HAPS Educator. In general, AI may not be used to create, write, produce, or analyze any part of a manuscript including figures and tables. As such, AI cannot be included as an author and should not be cited as a reference. The use of AI technology for managing references and minor editing of text is allowed. Examples are provided below of acceptable and unacceptable use of AI and AI-assisted services.

Authors who submit manuscripts written or enhanced by AI will violate this policy created by the HAPS Educator Board of Directors as of September 2024, making it impossible to be considered for publication.

AI may <u>not</u> be used by authors to:

- Write any part of text included in the manuscript.
- Analyze research results.
- Create graphs or figures.
- Modify or remove parts of an image created by others.

Al may be used by authors to:

- Check material written by the author for grammar and spelling.
- Use AI and AI-assisted services to improve sentence structure, text coherence, and readability.
- Check references (such as the use of reference managers) and use to create APAformatted references in the Literature Cited section.

To protect the confidentiality of the review process, no reviewer or editor of the HAPS Educator will upload any part of a submitted manuscript to an AI technology.
